Our Mission:

We Act gathers a mix of sport organisations to join efforts in transnational cooperation to face local/regional challenges of women integration, applying education through sport methodology.

The project will bring the EU dimension to local level; the development of social integration model for inclusion and diversity of women with fewer opportunities; the knowledge building, increase of work quality and transfer of best practices among sport and non-sport organizations; the awareness raising and increase of participation in sport of vulnerable women.



Our Impact:

➤ 4 partners will be involved: less experienced in Erasmus+ grass-root sport club as coordinator (ES), newcomer sport club (FR), less experienced sport association (NL) and experienced in the Erasmus+ Programme non-sport organisation, dealing with sport activities (BG). Local administrations' support will be ensured at the project milestones.

➤ 80 women with fewer opportunities from the 4 Member States will be involved in sport activities to test the developed training model for their better social inclusion and employability.

➤ 20 coaches/trainers from BG, FR, NL and ES will be involved in capacity-building, using the education through sport methodology to achieve empowerment of vulnerable women.

➤ 200 stakeholders will be involved in awareness-raising activities in the 4 partner countries. Additionally, around 3200 indirect beneficiaries will be reached through the planned We Act dissemination channels
